NEWS RELEASE

The North Stonington Resident Trooper's Office is currently investigating several thefts that have occurred in the Town of North Stonington during the past month. Power tools and associated construction equipment, generators, and landscape equipment to include trimmers and blowers have been taken. The thefts occurred during the overnight hours from locked trailers along Route 2.

There have also been residences which been burglarized during the daytime in town and in adjacent towns. On Wednesday afternoon, 09/15/10, a daytime burglary on Route 201 in Griswold (near the North Stonington Town Line) was interrupted by the homeowner. Troopers from Troop E responded and arrested the two males involved in the theft. On Saturday morning, 09/11/10, a commercial burglary of a strip mall occurred during the overnight on Route 165 in Preston, Connecticut.

Thefts from parked motor vehicles have been a problem in town in the past.

The North Stonington Resident State Troopers Office is seeking assistance with these investigations and is asking anyone with information to contact the Resident State Troopers at 860-535-1451.

Residents are reminded to be aware of their surroundings and to report suspicious activity to the North Stonington Resident State Troopers Office and/or Troop E Montville at 860-535-1451, or in an emergency by dialing 911. **When reporting such activity it is important to obtain identifying suspect descriptions (race, sex, age, clothing, number of persons involved) and vehicle information (make, model, color, vehicle registration, and other identifying characteristics).**
